

# **FITTING INSTRUCTIONS**

## **OMECW1 & OMECW2 CASTOR WEDGES**

### **VEHICLES WITH SPRINGS UNDER AXLE HOUSING**

Increase Castor Angle: Thin edge of wedge pointing rearward.

Decrease Castor Angle: Thick edge of wedge pointing rearward.

### **VEHICLES WITH SPRINGS ABOVE AXLE HOUSING**

Increase Castor Angle: Thick edge of wedge pointing rearward.

Decrease Castor Angle: Thin edge of wedge pointing rearward.

### **CAUTION:**

UNEQUAL WEDGES FITTED SIDE TO SIDE WILL NOT CORRECT SIDE TO SIDE CASTOR.

### **INSTALLATION:**

1. Loosen U bolts.
2. Insert correct degree castor wedge between spring seat and spring.
3. Ensure centre bolt locates castor wedge and engages spring seat.
4. Retighten U bolts to manufacturer's specification.

NOTE: After installation wheel alignment measurements should be rechecked to ensure that positive castor meets manufacturer's specifications.
